

Enriching Lives Through Art

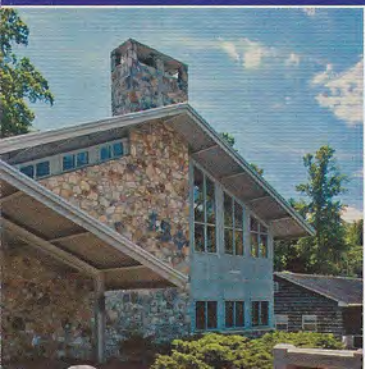
