Self-Guided Nature Trails

Map A Cades Cove; .66 mile; use of nature plants by early settlers.
Map B Elkmont; .75 mile; develop your ability to read the landscape.
Map C Laurel Falls; 2.5 miles; paced trail through a pine-oak forest
Map D Sugarlands - Fighting Creek; 1 mile; introduction to the natural and human history of the area.
Map E Noah Ogle; .75 mile; walk through an abandoned farmstead.
Map F Alum Cave; 5 miles; passes through a heath bald.
Map G Cosby; 1 mile; an introduction to an awareness of nature.

Trails not shown:

- Smokemont; .75 mile; examples from the past of man's impact on the land.
- Cove Hardwood; .75 mile; starting in second growth, the trail reaches a primeval forest.

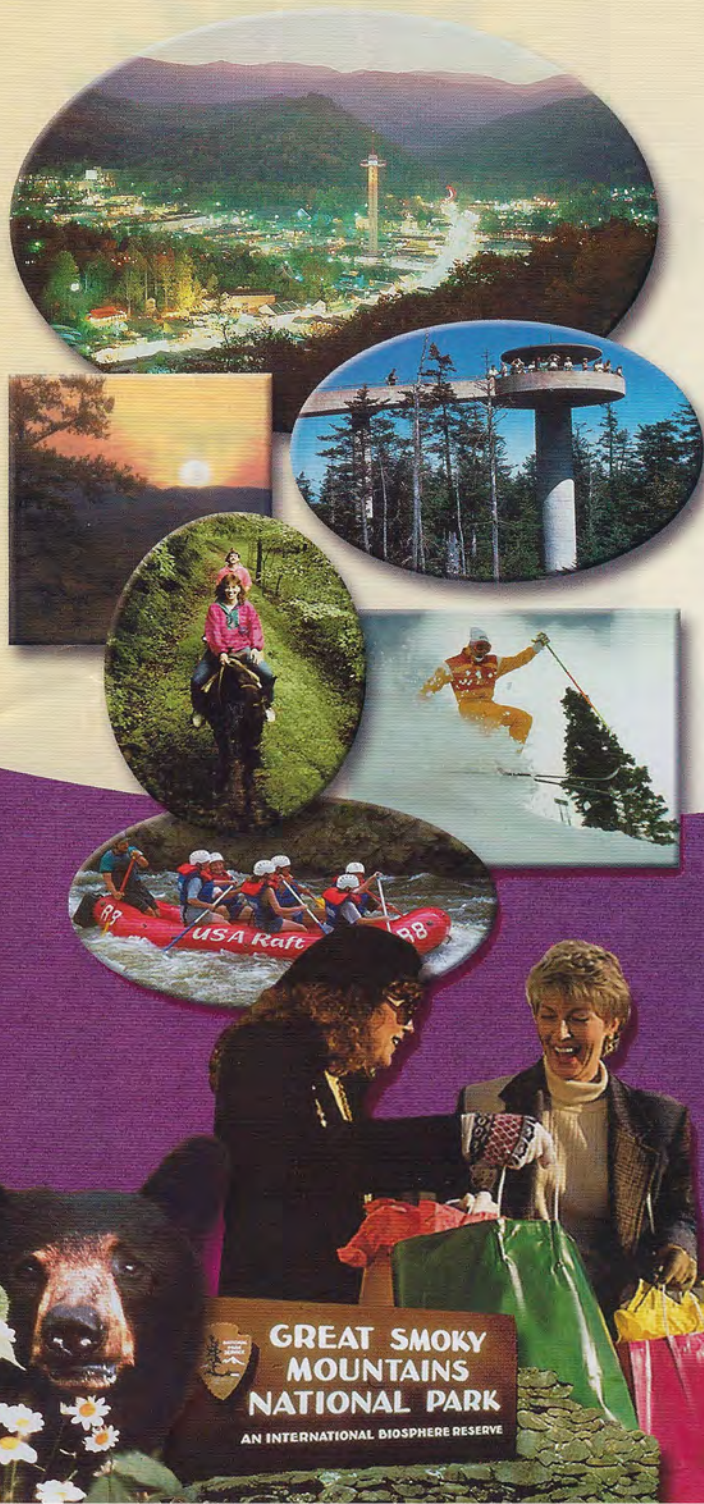

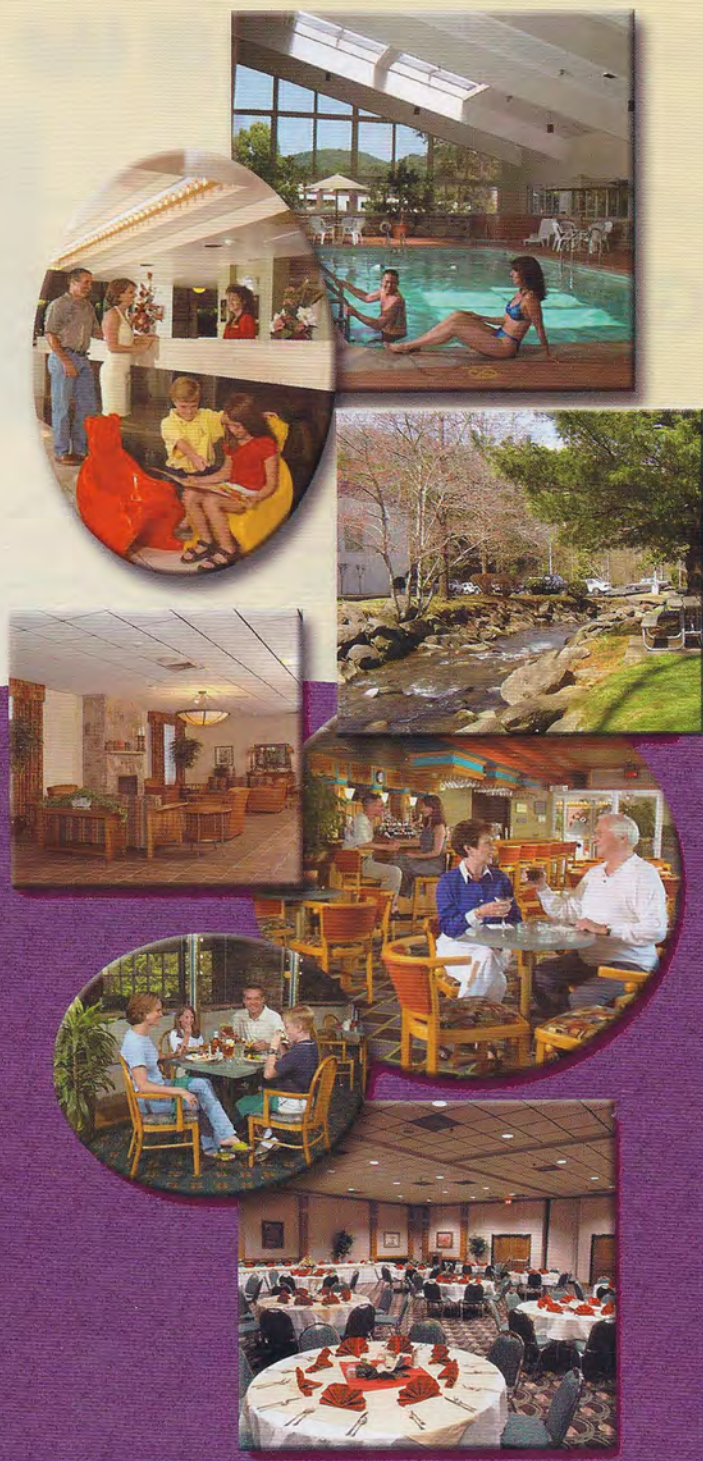
